Marla Simmons Stands Out at Bloomsburg

Former Advanced Hoops AAU Player Marla Simmons (Cedar Crest) has been rewarded for her outstanding play early this season at Bloomsburg University where she now plays her college basketball. Simmons (2009 participant on Coach Felker's Showcase Team) earned PSAC East Rookie of the week honors by averaging 8.3ppg and 2.7 rebounds per game in wins against USP and Lock Haven, and in a loss to Edinboro where Simmons stood out scoring 15 points, in a 10 for 10 effort from the line.

Early in the season Simmons has played in all 5 contests as a freshman averaging 5.2 ppg and shooting 15 for 17 from the free throw line (88.2%). She is also leading the team in field goal
